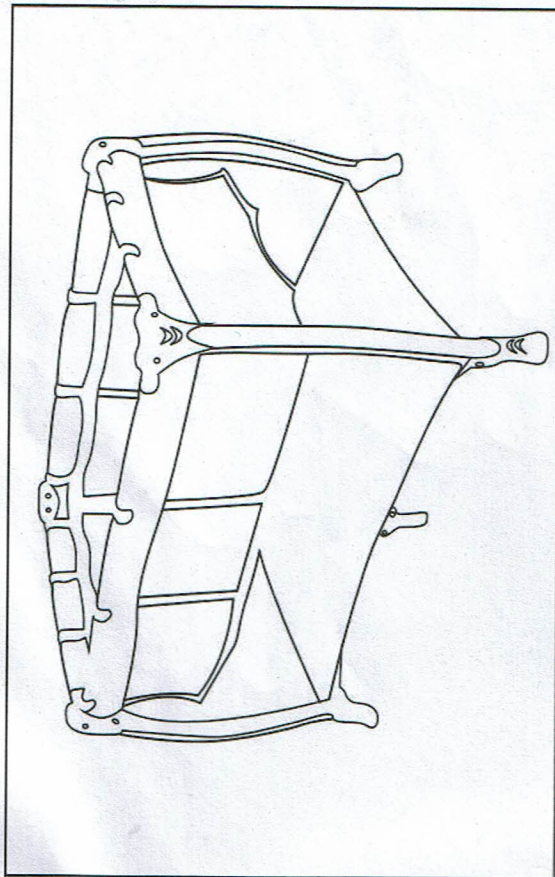

safety precautions

Before assembling this cot, read and understand the instructions. Do not use mattress other than the one supplied by the manufacturer. Incorrect mattress can cause death. Use only accessories as recommended by the manufacturer. Ensure the top rails and base are fully locked. Stop using this cot if any part of the cot is broken, torn or missing. Keep instructions in a safe place for future reference.

⚠WARNING

USE ONLY THE MATTRESS SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER, INCORRECT MATTRESS CAN CAUSE DEATH.
Use Only Accessories As Recommended By The Supplier.

Ensure The Top Rails And Base Are Fully Locked.

Do Not Use This Cot If Any Part Of The Cot Is Broken, Torn or Missing.

Failure to follow warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

Before assembly or each use, inspect your cot for damage, loose joints, missing or broken parts. **DO NOT** use your folding cot if any parts are missing or broken.

Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts or instructions if they are required. Never use substitute parts.

Keep children away while assembling/disassembling the cot.

Do not leave anything on the folding cot (such as toys) that provide a foothold.

Do not use the folding cot near naked heat sources, bar heaters, open fires or exposed flames.

Keep the folding cot clear of trailing cables and hanging cords.

Keep medication and small items that a child could choke on, away from the cot.

Do not use the folding cot if fabric or padding on the side rails or end rails has been bitten through.

FALL HAZARD – To prevent falls, **DO NOT** use the folding cot once the infant has reached the manufacturer's maximum weight of 13.6kgs or a height of 86.4cm tall.

SUFFOCATION HAZARD – Infants can suffocate;

- In gaps between an extra pad or mattress and the side of the bassinet/folding cot.

- In soft bedding.

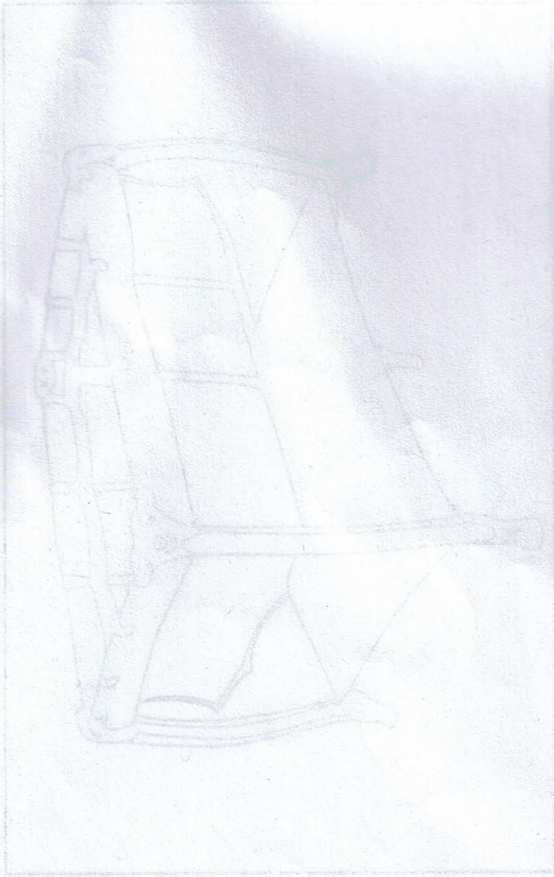
- Never add a mattress, pillow, comforter or padding. Use **ONLY** the mattress provided by the manufacturer.

Never leave your child unattended.

The mattress supplied is the required size suited for use with your travel cot. Using a wrong sized or an additional mattress may create hazardous gaps that could result in suffocation or could reduce the side height of the cot, which may result in your child falling out and being injured.

Use this product with only one child at a time.

To reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS), pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.

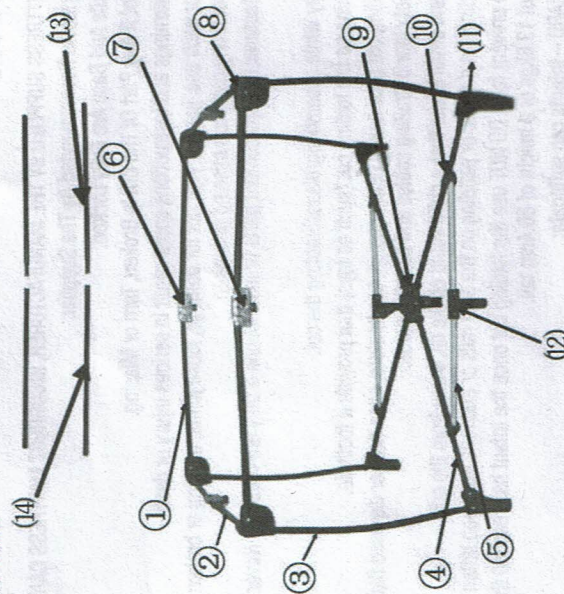

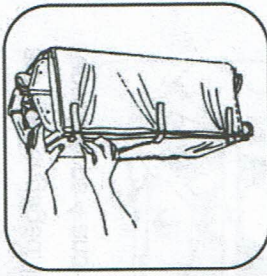

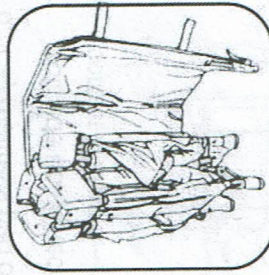

To Set up the Travel Cot

1. Unzip the bag and remove the travel cot standing it in an upright position.

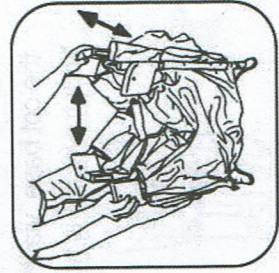


2. Un-hook the three velcro tabs on the outer side of the mattress and remove the padded mattress.

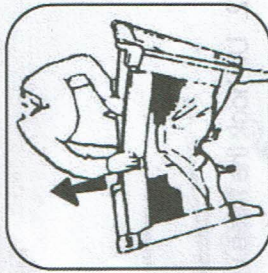


3. Separate the four corner posts.

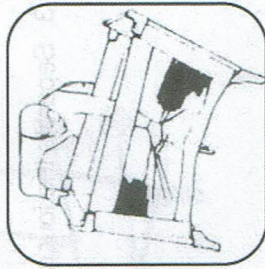
4. Lift the four side rails upwards from the middle until each lock into position.



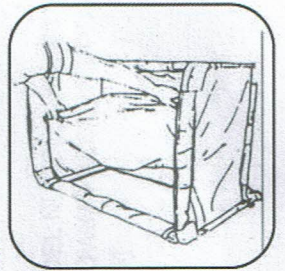
5. Push down the centre support until it locks into position, check and ensure all the locking devices are fully engaged. If not, lift the centre support and repeat steps 4 and 5.



6. Lay mattress pad on the floor of the travel cot, soft side up. Check the assembly of the cot is correct and safe.

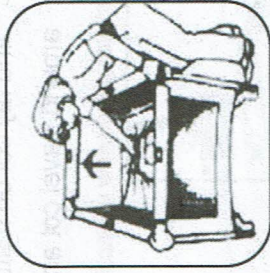


7. Fix the velcro fasteners under the mattress onto the cot base, via the two holes in the cot base. Your travel cot is now ready to use

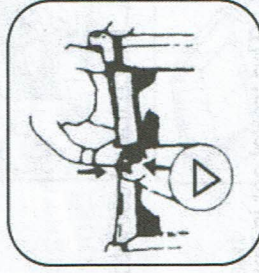


To Fold the Travel Cot

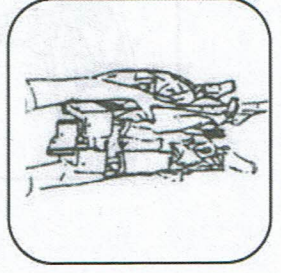
1. Unfasten the velcro fasteners underneath the cot, and remove mattress pad.



2. Grasp centre strap: pull up to its highest point. Use care as it may release forcefully.



3. Lift the top rail, and squeeze the button under the centre of the rail, until the side rails release downwards. Repeat for each side rail.



Bassinet assembly

⚠ Warning:

THIS BASSINET SHOULD BE REMOVED BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP. NEVER PLACE A CHILD IN THE COT WHEN THIS BASSINET IS IN PLACE. TO PREVENT FALLS, THE BASSINET MUST NOT BE USED ONCE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP. USE ONLY THE MATTRESS SUPPLIED BY THE MANUFACTURER. INCORRECT MATTRESS CAN CAUSE DEATH.

Maximum weight limit for bassinet is 8kgs.

Use this product with only one child at a time.

Always ensure the wheel brakes are in the locked position when using the travel cot.

Bassinet assembly (cont.)

- 1 Take out parts of bassinet from provided bag.
- 2 Hook bassinet onto the travel cot rails. Make sure all sixteen hooks are securely hooked.

WARNING: TO AVOID OF ENTRAPMENT HAZARD, PLEASE ATTACH THE HOOK EQUALITY ON EACH RAIL, MAKE SURE EACH EDGE OF BASSINET TIGHTLY LEAN AGAINST ON EACH RAIL.

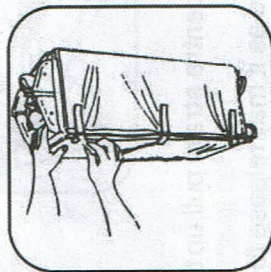
- 3 Take poles "A" and "B" and join together, insert one end into pocket on bassinet base, then insert other end into velcro pocket. Wrap velcro straps around poles at centre. Place mattress pad inside bassinet. Fix the ten velcro fasteners under the mattress pad onto the bassinet base.

To disassemble the bassinet

Reverse all previous steps under "Bassinet assembly".

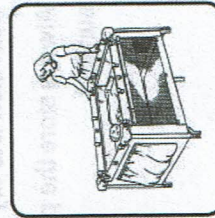
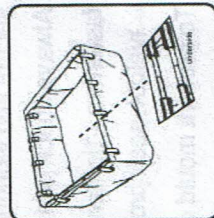
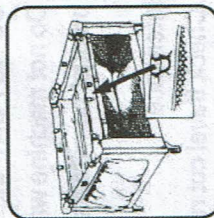
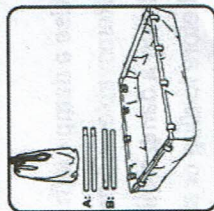
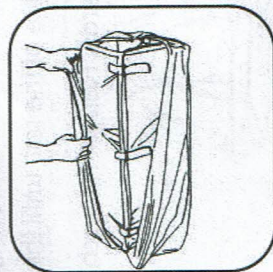
4. Gather unit together.

5. Lay mattress pad on floor - soft side up and lay cot on mattress pad. Wrap mattress pad around travel cot and fasten the three velcro tabs.



6. Place travel cot into bag and zip together.

7. The travel cot is now ready for easy carrying or storage.



How to Care for your Travel Cot

Cleaning

- Use a damp cloth to clean the frame. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Removable and non removable fabric covers and trims may be cleaned using a damp cloth with soap or mild detergent. Allow it dry completely before folding or storing it away.
- DO NOT DRY CLEAN, OR USE BLEACH ON FABRICS OR TRIMS.**
- Do not machine wash, tumble or spin dry, unless the care labelling on the product permits these methods.

Maintenance

- Check travel cot regularly to ensure that locking devices & components are secure and working properly.
- Always check parts regularly for tightness of screws, nuts and other fasteners – tighten or replace if required. To maintain the safety of your travelcot, seek prompt repairs for bent, torn, worn or broken parts.
- To prevent mould or mildew, do not fold or store the product if it is damp or wet. Allow it to dry thoroughly.
- Always store the product in a well ventilated area and away from direct sunlight.
